ANCC AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP 2008

BULLETIN No. 11/ 2008 (Issued 24 October 2008)

Hi All,

We are now nearing the end of the year with the last few events nearing completion. On the 5th of October Ilkley & DMC organised Round 10 of the 2008 ANCC Autotest Championship at a new venue at Askam Bryan College near York. Thanks must go to Ilkley & DMC for securing this venue, which was enjoyed by those taking part, and apparently there could be more space available.

It was pleasing that there were 9 Championship registered competitors out of the entry of 13 taking part, on one of the better days of late, with good sunshine.

There were 19 tests in total, which resulted in 7 washouts and plenty of penalties catching out the unwary. In addition there were plenty of kerbs to keep an eye and if your sight wandered then it could be damaging as Christopher Chapman found out, but still managed 2nd in Class behind Stephen Morten and in front of his father Ian Chapman.

In the large engined Minis, David and Adele Mosey turned out in their 1400 Mini saloon, as they were preparing the Special for the Ken Wharton invitation event on which Adele was representing the England ladies team, and also needed a little practice. David took the Class win from Howard Everingham, with Adele finally finishing in third spot.

In the specials Class David Sowman came out on his local Club's event to take second place behind Duncan Wild, who was the furthest travelled competitor from Knutsford, well over the 'hill' – geographically speaking not personally, and Steven Haigh ending his day with 3rd in class before he lays the car up for the winter overhaul in preparation for 2010.

Within the ANCC Championship, I have to report no change again in Classes 1,2 & 4 with David Goodlad, Carl Sams and Howard Everingham taking the lead respectively. In Class 5 Ian Chapman is still the leader, with Stephen Morten 2nd and Ben Morten joined by Christopher Chapman, who shot up from 5th, in joint 3rd.

In the Specials Class 6 Duncan Wild has retained his 1st from Steven Haigh and David Mosey retaining 3rd.

In the overall position Howard Everingham is still leading the field with a near perfect 158 points.
