ANCC AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP 2008

BULLETIN No. 09/ 2008 (Issued 01 October 2008)

Hi All

Following close on the heels of the previous Bulletin, I now report on Round 8 of the ANCC Autotest Championship the Alwoodley MC event held on 14 September 2008 at Rufforth Airfield near York.

Unfortunately this event was also blighted with a low entry from our Registered competitors with only 12 entries of which 7 were Championship competitors. Like the previous event a closed to Club Autosolo, with 8 entries, was running alongside the main event,

Within the Championship there were only two classes represented – 'Sports Cars' with Ian Chapman, Stephen & Ben Morten and 'Specials' with David and Adele Mosey, Howard Everingham and Steven Haigh.

The first casualty was the Striker of Stephen & Ben Morten, which suffered terminal problems such that Stephen chose to have an early bath and Ben 'borrowed' Ian Chapman's similar car. Although a similar car it is not the same as the one you are used to and Ben soon took to the handling of his new transport and was swapping times with Ian Chapman over the first half of the tests. Over the second half of the tests these two were closer in times with Ian eventually taking the Class win after Ben took a washout late on in the proceedings which more than likely cost him the class win.

In the specials, which included the reclassified mini of Howard Everingham, something he is getting used to this year, along with regulars, David and Adele Mosey and Steven Haigh. Dave Mosey stamped his authority from the start to take the Class win from Howard, the only blemish being a washout towards the end of the first half of the tests. Leaving Adele Mosey and Steven Haigh fighting for the other two places, with Adele taking it from Steven.

Unlike the previous event, in July, organised by Alwoodley MC at Rufforth there were noticeably very few penalties and only four washouts with Steven Haigh picking up two after securing a 'clean sheet' on the previous event.

As far as the Championship goes Class leaders have not changed in 1, 2 & 4 with David Goodlad, Carl Sams and Howard Everingham respectively. In Class 5 Ian Chapman maintains his lead and son Christopher has moved to 3rd with Ben Morten 'nicking' 2nd. Finally in Class 6 Steven Haigh again maintains his Class leads but Dave Mosey taking 2nd after swapping places with Duncan Wild.
