ANCC AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP 2009

BULLETIN No. 12 / 2009 (Issued 28 February 2010)

Hi All,

Whilst trying to finalise the events for the 2009 ANCC Autotest Championship it became apparent, that when I issued the amended Bulletin 11 and the Results after the Knutsford & DMC round, and the later cancellation of what would have been our last round, Durham AC, I overlooked the fact that I had not issued the final Championship positions. As a result there were no changes from the amended Bulletin 11 results, except that I had not identified the award winners although I had prepared the Final results on 12 November 2009 but not distributed them, for this oversight I apologise.

Final Awards:

2009 Champion – Howard Everingham – Beverley & DMC (Morris Mini 1400)

Class 1 Winner – David Goodlad – Knutsford & DMC (Mini Clubman 1071)

Class 2 Winner – Lee Valentine - Durham AC (Nova)

Class 5 Winner – Stephen G. Morten – Alwoodley MC (RAW Striker 1800)

Class 5 2nd – Ian Chapman – Alwoodley MC (Striker 1800)

Class 6 Winner – Duncan Wild – Knutsford & DMC (ABS Freestyle 1400)

Class 2 was not awarded as the winner was the Champion and the Parent and Offspring team was not awarded due to insufficient entries.

For 2010 I have three issues:

- Class makeup
- Road Saloons class
- Class for Novices

Class Makeup

In the last Bulletin I asked for help in trying to rearrange the Class structure because a number of classes have few entries (only 1 or 2). Unfortunately I did not have one call offering assistance – with time now run out I will have to utilize the classes as they stand.

Road Saloons Class

This class was added to encourage newcomers (i.e. Novices), unfortunately this had little effect, but will still be included.

Class for Novices

Another idea for newcomers so that they do not have to compete against seasoned competitors is create a Novice class. This has resulted from a couple of enquiries from potential new to the Championship competitors, asking the question with respect to a Novice class.

2010 Championship

Now for 2010 ANCC Autotest Championship, I am waiting for the Championship permit to arrive then the Regulations will be distributed/ available. The events are similar to last year but starting with Hartlepool & DMC event on 18 April followed by Bolton le Moors CC on 25 April. I was trying to eliminate events on consecutive weekends, but because of the lack of suitable events, this would reduce the number of events, as a result at least two clubs have asked if they can be part of the Championship and accept they could 'take a hit' therefore I have included them, the choice is theirs. All I ask is that you support as many events as you are able. Furthermore there are still two dates to be confirmed, I am still negotiating with Durham AC to bring forward their November date and depending on the result of that will decide what date the second Alwoodley MC event will run.

Finally I would like to thank all Clubs who allowed their events to be part of the ANCC Autotest Championship 2009, and to you the competitors for being part of the Championship.
