ANCC AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP 2009

BULLETIN No. 05 – 08 / 2009 (Issued 09 September 2009)

Hi All,

Two apologies:

Firstly I have apologise to Keith Walton who successfully completed Round 1 of the Championship at Bolton, yet I omitted him from the results although I mentioned his performance in the write up within Bulletin 3 – sorry. For that reason I re-issue the results associated with Bulletins 3 and 4 dated and marked 'amended'.

Secondly and most important is that I appeared to have had a 'long sleep' – not so the chance would have been useful. Time constraints and personal demands have overtaken me – I hope that is now behind me and I will proceed.

BULLETIN 5 (Round 3 Bolton le Moors)

There were only 7 registered competitors entered this event which comprised over half the total entry. With some 20 tests it guaranteed a long day but with a very poor overall entry they were soon executed. There were few penalties and David Goodlad and Christopher Chapman each having 2 maximums and Howard Everingham, Ian Chapman and Duncan Wild all having clean sheets with Duncan finally taking FTD, Stephen Morten 2nd and Ian Chapman 3rd. Class winners were Howard Everingham, Stephen Morten and Steven Haigh

BULLETIN 6 (Round 4 Hartlepool)

With a very good overall entry all our registered competitors had entered. Most competitors had 1 or 2 penalties, although there were a number of maximums with Stephen & Ben Morten having 4 each at the end of the meeting which would seem to indicate a mechanical problem. There were only 2 clean sheets, Tom Hall (2nd in class) and Duncan Wild (5th in class). Class winners were Howard Everingham, Lee Valentine and Richard Pinkney who finished 2nd overall, only some 9 secs. down.

BULLETIN 7 (Round 5 Knutsford)

By far the best entry to date and only 12 tests but ensured a full day, with most of our registered competitors entered. This time there were plenty of penalties scattered about. Howard Everingham did not have a good run by having 6 maximums on the last six tests suggesting a mechanical problem. Another with seemingly similar problems was Ian Chapman. Best class results were 2nd with Lee Valentine, David Goodlad and Richard Pinkney who was our highest place competitor at 3rd overall and Stephen Morten 5th overall.

BULLETIN 8 (Round 6 Alwoodley)

This time we had 5 tests on 3 sites giving a total of 15 tests, which proved interesting as there seemed to be more maximums than penalties. Our best finisher was Richard Pinkney who finished 2nd overall (1st in class) by the only 7 secs. Howard Everingham and Lee Valentine each finished 2nd in their classes.

The next round was again to be organised by **ALWOODLEY M.C.** and run by yours truly on 13 September 2009, unfortunately I was unable to orgaine the event as I was unavailable, and on this date and an alternative the chosen venue was in use. Therefore reluctantly the event has been **POSTPONED** to a date hopefully in late October or early November. **I must offer my sincere apologies for this extremely late notice but was primarily my fault.**
