## **ANCC AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP 2010**

### **BULLETIN No. 03/ 2010 (Issued 09 July 2010)**

Hi All

Please accept my apologies for the delay in forwarding this update, but I prepared this Bulletin on 04 July 2010, after eventually receiving the results for the Hartlepool Autotest, but then received two further amendments, I hope this is the final version.

After the disappointment of two cancelled rounds we are back on the road with Round 5 the Hartlepool & DMC event on 27 June 2010 at their new venue.

Further good news is that our registrations are up to nine and we had all but one of those entered in this round, obviously hungry for some competition, although the total entry for the event was a little low.

Unfortunately one of our registered competitors, Ian Chapman, did not start, but the event appeared to be a generally close fought event.

In Class A (Minis) with Paul Swift in contention it would always be a little difficult for Howard Everingham and David Goodlad, on paper. With Paul perhaps a little rusty picked up a wrong direction and a number of cones, such that David Goodlad was just pipping him by the break with Howard leading. After the break Paul put the hammer down with only one cone and a string of quick times to take the class win. David Goodlad also took a number of tests from Howard Everingham but ended the day third behind Howard.

In Class C there was unusually only three entries with Ian Chapman non starting, ended with a two horse race. Christopher Chapman took the second test from Stephen Morten but after picking up a few cones never headed Stephen for the rest of the day to take second in Class behind Stephen.

Finally Class D (Specials), our best entry, and the biggest Class entry of the day and with some of the best Autotesters in the land meant that a good result needed a 'clean sheet'. With a number of penalties of all kinds it appeared to level things in the mid order even though the outright winner had a wrong direction on test one. Our best in this Class was Duncan Wild who actually had two wrong tests and a cone to finish 5<sup>th</sup> in Class, closely followed by David Sowman in 7<sup>th</sup> place who also had a wrong direction and a cone on his first Championship outing of the year. Finally Steven Haigh who appeared to have a difficult day but still kept in touch with David Sowman, taking a number of tests from him to finish 11<sup>th</sup> in Class.

I repeat my plea from the last Bulletin, and note with the cancellation of two events, to date, that means that Championship Rule 6.5 comes into operation, therefore the Championship will now be decided over 'Best 7' events out of the 12 nominated, of which there are 7 rounds left - **SO THERE IS PLENTY TO GO FOR – please support your Championship.** I attach copy of Championship Regulations for those who have not yet entered.
