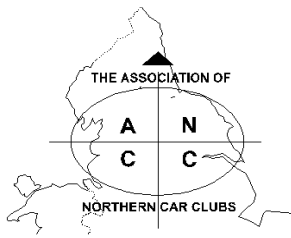

2010 AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP

REGULATIONS (Issue 4)

1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Association of Northern Car Clubs will promote an Autotest championship during 2010 to be known as the ANCC 2010 Autotest Championship.

It is a class based championship, which is intended to provide all comers with a reasonably equal opportunity of achieving success, whatever type of car they choose to drive in the competition.

2. PERMIT No.

MSA Championship Registration **No. 71/2010** has been issued.

3. ELIGIBILITY

The Championship is open to every member of all the member clubs of the Association of Northern Car Clubs.

4. REGISTRATION

The registration fee of **£10.00** should be sent to:

together with a completed registration form (cheques/PO's payable to 'ANCC Autotest Championship' please). Registration must be effected PRIOR to an event in order to score points in that event.

5. CLASSES

- A. Saloon Cars under 11feet (3.35metres) (Note a)
- B. Saloon Cars over 11 Feet (3.35 metres) (Note a)
- C. Sports Cars & Sports Kit Cars
- D. Specials
- E. Road going saloons (Note b) – Best 5 events to count
- F. Novice (Note c) – Best 5 events to count
- G. Family Team (of 2 – Parent and son / daughter)

Notes:

- (a) All lengths refer to the overall length, as listed in Parkers Car Price Guide (January edition of the Championship year)
- (b) All vehicles in this class will be capable of being driven on the road, must be taxed and have a current M.O.T. test certificate (if applicable), documents to be produced at Scrutineering.
- (c) Anyone who has previously not won more than two Class wins at the start of the Championship year.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Points will be awarded to all registered competitors, according to their finishing position in each for each event, as follows: 1st in class, 20 points; down to 19th in class, 2 points. All other classified finishers will be awarded 1 point each. Non-finishers and retirements will receive 0 points. 1st overall (FTD) is classified as 1st in class, the rest of that class scoring accordingly
- 6.2 Points will be scored using the actual event classes, including class mergers, and may not be the classes of this Championship. Points scored in such classes will be credited to the competitors' Championship class. It is felt that this better reflects the level of competition encountered on the day.
- 6.3 Ties will be resolved as follows: the winner is the one with the highest score from the number of qualifying rounds attempted as set out in 6.4 and 6.5 from those events on which the tied competitors have competed against each other. Then it is whoever made the highest score first.
- 6.4 If a tie remains, then on the first event on which they both competed together, they will be awarded a point for whenever they beat their next competitor in their class on each test over all the tests on the day by the biggest margin. The winner being the registered competitor with most points. Should a tie still exist, the registered competitor who beat his next competitor on the first test by the largest margin will be the winner. Then the 2nd test and so on until the tie is resolved.
- 6.5 Regarding event cancellations, there will be no change in the number of qualifying rounds required down to and including 12 events, then for up to every 2 events cancelled, 1 less will count for the Championship.
- 6.6 The ANCC Autotest Champion will be the registered competitor who scores the highest number of points from 8 or fewer events (minimum 5).

7. ADVERTISING

If the Championship receives any sponsor decals and / or the ANCC produce any decals, it will be required to display **ONE decal on each side of the vehicle**, in a prominent visible position.

8. AWARDS

To qualify for an award, a competitor must score in at least 5 events. Awards will be presented as follows:

1 st overall, ANCC Championship Winner.....	ANCC Trophy and an award
1 st in each class.....	An award
2 nd in each class.....	An award (subject to 4 registrations minimum)
3 rd in each class.....	An award (subject to 7 registrations minimum)
Best Lady – Overall.....	An award
Best Novice – Overall	An award
2 nd Novice – Overall	An Award (subject to 4 registrations minimum)
1 st Team (Parent and Son/Daughter)	An Award (subject to 3 teams)

10. EVENT ENTRIES

It is the responsibility of individual contenders to secure an entry for individual qualifying events. A list of registered contenders will be circulated to all event organisers prior to each event, OR regulations will be circulated by the Championship coordinator. Competitors to check individual events themselves if in doubt.

11. RESULTS

Championship scores and current positions are planned to be available at the start of each event. **These to be** supplemented by interim bulletins, **issued by e-mail or post to those not connected to the internet**, giving current scores, positions, news, event information, dates, changes and anything else of interest.
