Concerns had been raised at previous meetings regarding improving the number of entries at grass root motor sport level, The South West Association has had similar thoughts and have drafted a proposal. It was agreed the ANCC would support their proposal.

BEN TAYLOR – GO Motorsport

The meeting welcomed Ben Taylor. Ben is an independent advisor and looks after Communications and Marketing on behalf of the MSA. Ben reported that the “Lets Go Karting” promotion had attracted over 3000 8-14-year olds, and was one way of attracting new people into the sport. Go Motorsport was launched in June with over 160 clubs registering their details. The first six months has gone well with high profile “stars” supporting the initiative, coverage on ITV and 5000 people visiting the website.

2009 will see more PR, a simplified website and more upto date information on the website. A more direct approach and hopefully the introduction of “regional contacts” to get more people and clubs involved.

“GO Motorsport” will be the umbrella to get more involved – any ideas then let Ben know.

The question was raised regarding the poor readability of the Go Motorsport stickers – these are being revamped. Their advert is free and can be placed on regs and on any event programmes – Go Motorsport is a benefit to everyone. A second question was also asked regarding bringing the “older fat and forties” club into the sport? There is going to be a marketing campaign with Saga and race tracks to encourage them into the sport.

Local Press is an excellent way across to the public and informing people as to exactly what is available.

Whether you’re a spectator, official or a competitor – GO Motorsport should be the central introduction point.
